Student Programme

- Every year you will meet or hear from at least one employer visiting college.
- Every year you will have access to careers guidance during PSHE.
- You will have access to the Unifrog platform to research careers, and record your experiences.
- Be given guidance on choosing a suitable career path.
- The opportunity to research a career of your choice in depth.
- Provided with information about the local labour market.
- In Year 11 all students will receive at least one individual careers interview with a specialist careers advisor.
- There will be opportunities to take part in university visits.
- In Year 11 you will have the opportunity to attend the careers fair to meet prospective employers and post-16 course providers.
- In Year 11 you have the opportunity to partake in a mock interview with a local employer.
- In Year 11 you will receive information from local sixth form colleges and post 16 providers.
- By the end of Year 11 completed a CV to use in college and employment interviews.
- The potential to take part in a virtual work experience programme.
- In Year 9 you will receive support to help you make choices about the subjects to study in Years 10 and 11.
