Year 11 Final Week Arrangements

Further to our letter dated 13th May please find more detailed information below about the arrangements for this week.

Tuesday 8th June – only students in 11ASH, 11BWO and 11JGO to attend college

Wednesday 9th June – only students in 11RLE, 11KPE and 11PDN to attend college

PE kit and blazers should be worn and basic equipment brought when attending college.

Attendance on their set day is part of the Future Passport criteria for an invitation to Thursday's Leavers' Event. Invitation to the Leavers' Event will be issued on Wednesday evening by text message to parents and carers. A reminder that the criteria for receiving an invitation are:

- Produce an approved, good quality CV and personal statement
- No outstanding GCSE portfolio work
- Agreed post-16 plan evidenced
- 0 BIC sanctions
- No more than 1 detention of any type
- Attendance daily (authorised absence will need to be evidenced)
- Receive 0 negative sanctions above a -1
- All items from LRC returned or paid for
- Meet college expectations around conduct, behaviour and treating others with respect.

Text messages to those invited will be sent by 8 pm on Wednesday evening.

Students wishing to attend the Leavers' Event MUST take an LFD home test on Wednesday evening and record their results on the college form. Failure to take a test and submit a result will result in them not being able to attend. This is a change from the optional testing that has taken place since March due to the risk assessment measures necessary for having a whole year group spending time together. Results must be recorded by 7.30 pm to allow for invitations to be sent out.

On Thursday 10th June all invited students should wear their PE kit and blazer for the Leavers' Assembly and Event.


