Throughout the academic year, we have tracked the progress of your son/daughter using a suite of nationally standardised tests in English, maths and science, along with a series of Cognitive Ability Tests (CAT4). You can view a short video explaining these tests [here](#).

The results of CAT4 and progress tests help us identify ways we can help students make progress, and can also give indications as to likely future performance. The following table summarises how the tests are scored.

Standardised score	Ability band	% students nationally
127+	Very High	4
112-126	Above Average	19
89-111	Average	54
74-88	Below Average	19
73-	Very Low	4
