Dear Parents and Carers of Year 10 Students

We have been made aware of two positive Covid-19 cases in Year 10. As a consequence, a large proportion of the year group are required to self-isolate.

For this reason, we are asking all Year 10 students to stay at home and access their learning remotely tomorrow (Thursday 15th July) and on Friday 16th July.

Lessons for Year 10 tomorrow and Friday will take place live over Microsoft Teams, following students' timetables, in exactly the same way as during the January/ February closure period.

During this evening we will contact the parents/ carers of those students who will need to self-isolate as a result of the most recent case. If you do not hear from us your child does not need to self-isolate but should still remain at home and access their lessons remotely.

For students who have to this point not been identified as a contact, we are able to offer a small in college provision for vulnerable students and the children of critical workers. If you would like to request a place on this provision, please contact us on enquiries@springwellcc.org.
